



Covid-19 Policy (March 2022)

As of **March 12, 2022**, the Washington DOH and Governor Inslee have lifted the mask mandate for most counties in our state. After careful consideration, I have decided to lift the mask mandate in my music studio as well. **Masks are no longer mandated in my studio. However, I also leave masking up to your own personal decision.** I, and families/students in our classes will respect your choice whether to mask or not to mask.

I promise to keep those entering into and living in my home/studio, safe, to the best of my ability. **I will clean daily before and after classes, sanitize equipment, and limit sharing of instruments and manipulatives. I am fully vaccinated, and so is everyone in my family.**

When you come to class I highly suggest:

1. Please wash your hands or use the provided sanitizer at the beginning of class.
2. Please remove your shoes at the front porch.

If, by chance someone in my home or in my classes, does contract Covid at any time, appropriate measures will be taken. This may mean quarantining and postponing of classes for a needed time.

Those involved in classes at my home, agree to abide by these guidelines, and agree to not hold Mrs. Leslie and her family liable if, by chance Covid is spread unknowingly to themselves, their family members, or others in the class, if exposure happens to occur.
